Notes from January 10, 2019 Meeting Subway on Edgewood

Attending: Janeen Osborne, Celeste Koon, Kathleen Henley, Stephanie McClerran

1. Kathleen Henley said the treasury had an ending balance of \$290.75 for calendar year 2018 and she is going to file our tax form. In 2019 she reimbursed Celeste Koon for the \$82.00 that Celeste gave the Parks Foundation for benches on the Frog Hollow trail. The current balance is \$208.75.

2. There are now 104 members in the Facebook group.

3. Parks has not yet constructed the benches at Frog Hollow. The group identified the locations in early November, but the weather has been bad since then. Some items from the trail improvements hike have been completed, and the entire trail has been de-bermed (debris removed from the downhill edge).

4. Those present decided that funds raised in the coming year would be contributed to trail condition signage at Binder.

5. A suggestion for installing boulders for a bicycle trials area in North Jefferson City was also discussed.

6. ORTA is still waiting on a notice to proceed before trail work sessions for the new trails at Binder can be announced.

7. A draft report about a possible construction of a short trail behind the new fire station on East McCarty Street was discussed. Suggestions were to include some fitness stations along the trail, and possible play elements like slack lines.

8. A postcard-size flyer was discussed and several good suggestions were received. Celeste said she and Brandy Bergthold will try to distribute some flyers in the next few weeks.

9. The group discussed holding a scavenger hunt again. This year it will be held in early May along the greenway in Washington Park. A date will be set a little later.

10. Another suggestion was to have a wine and cheese party at Memorial Park in April or May, and Celeste will inquire about the Memorial Pavilion.

11. Celeste is looking for an opportunity to speak to a group about Jefferson City Trail Users, possibly near Earth Day.

12. The state has not yet accepted the Rock Island trail and calls to the governor and state parks director are encouraged.

13. The next meeting will be from 6-7 pm on February 13, 2019 at Subway on West Edgewood.
