

Notes from the October 16, 2019 Meeting Subway on West Edgewood

Attending: Kathleen Henley, Celeste Koon, and Janeen Osborne

1. Kathleen Henley reported the treasury balance is now \$444.70.

2. Celeste reported there are 119 active members in the Facebook group.

3. The fundraiser at the Old Munichberg Octoberfest was discussed. Those helping with the booth were Kathleen and Mark Henley, Janeen Osborne, Karen Dunkle, Amy Hedrick, Lori Henley, Celeste Koon, Brandy Bergthold, Jodie Bontrager, and George and Donna Hagedorn. \$87 was raised toward the benches on the Frog Hollow Trail. Everyone had a great time! But since the sales of pictures were low, the group will sign up for a booth next year at the University Extension Craft Show at the Fairgrounds. It is the weekend after Labor Day and this year 3,900 people paid an entrance fee to come in and shop. Celeste will sign up for a booth. The cost is about the same as for the Octoberfest.

Several ideas about the fundraiser were brought up: We will try to have some pictures on display showing what the JC Trial Users do. We may try to sell some larger pictures or magnets. Seasonal pictures and some pictures of structures will be included instead of mostly trees and rivers. A calendar may be considered.

4. Final plans were made for handing out coffee and donuts at the Edgewood Greenway Trailhead on Oct. 19. (This event occurred and not too many donuts were handed out, but Lori and Kathleen Henley talked to a few people, and \$11 was received in donations for benches on the Frog Hollow Trail. Some trail work was also done on the Frog Hollow Trail.)

5. JJ Gates has said the benches will be installed this fall.

6. A couple dates for the ORTA trail projects at Binder were announced and one more is coming up on October 26 at 1:00 pm.

7. A copy of the letter the group sent to MODOT commending the agency for the new sidewalks along Missouri Blvd. was passed around.

8. The next annual trail improvements hike at Frog Hollow will be on November 10 at 3:00 pm. Meet at the memorial bench directly across from Anytime Fitness.

9. Celeste will work with Amy Hedrick to put pictures of area trails and a short description of the trails on the website.

10. People are encouraged to attend the Land Use Open House for the City's Comprehensive Plan about what you would like to see in the future in Jefferson City. This will be on October 24 from 3:00-7:00 pm at City Hall. A good thing to mention among others is that you enjoy greenways and trails.

12. The need to distribute more flyers was mentioned and Celeste will check with Brandy about doing this.
