Notes from the August 19, 2020 Meeting Outside Subway on West Edgewood

- 1. Kathleen Henley reported the treasury balance is now \$419.70 thanks to additional dues being received.
- 2. Celeste reported there are currently 182 members in the Facebook group.
- 3. The Fall Festival, which was to be the event for the annual fundraiser, has been cancelled. The group will try selling its unique outdoor photos in unique frames on Facebook. Celeste will start posting the pictures in September and this strategy will be evaluated at the next meeting.
- 4. The next Get Acquainted Hike will be at Eagle Bluffs on Sunday, September 13, leaving at 1:00 pm from the North Jefferson City commuter lot by the pavilion. A hike at Painted Rocks will be held on Saturday, October 10. More details to come.
- 5. It was noted that ORTA members have been working at Binder and work continues on the east side of the lake where a mile of new trail is being added. The NICA student racing which was to be held on the trails at Binder has been cancelled. The Tall Oak Challenge has also been cancelled.
- 6. The trail condition signs are not in place yet. Work on them had halted but should be underway again.
- 7. Letters to Mayor Tergin and to the League of American Bicyclists were reviewed. The letters commended city staff for their work on Dunklin St. by the greenway,
- 8. Frog Hollow maintenance has been going well and the trail is in good shape. The group reviewed the list of trail improvements that were identified in the past two years. All but 4 have been completed. Work will be done on the remaining projects this fall.
- 9. The next meeting date is September 16th from 6-7 pm at Subway on West Edgewood.
