Notes from the October 13, 2021 Meeting

1. Kathleen Henley reported the Treasury has a balance of \$248.42 following the donation of an additional \$300 to the JC Parks Foundation for signage at Binder Lake.
2. There are currently 378 members in the Facebook group.
3. Rick Thom's report on the Greenberry Acres trail was sent to Parks staff. Schwartz replied that trail improvements will be attempted late this year.
4. The next Get Acquainted hike will be held on trails between Riverside Park and the Lewis and Clark State Office Building. Meet at the Lewis and Clark Building on Riverside Drive at 11 am on Sunday, October 17. The November Get Acquainted hike will be on November 14th at Rock Bridge. Meet at 11 am in the Devil's Ice Box parking lot. No formal hike will be scheduled in December.
5. Frog Hollow trail work will be held this Sunday, October 17, from 3:30-4:30 pm. Meet at the Anytime Fitness parking lot and bring a rake.
6. Brandy Bergthold sent additional comments to the Missouri Conservation Department in favor of allowing bicycles on service roads.
7. About 39 photos were sold at the Fall Festival. Celeste reported she has acquired about 20 new frames for next year. Dan Bernskoetter will provide a larger picture for a picture that will hang on the wall. The group agreed that one of his eagle pictures would look good in a larger frame that is available. Celeste will follow up with Dan. The picture might be advertised for sale after the November meeting.
8. Celeste gave an update about the NICA race on the trails at Binder on Halloween. Members may want to volunteer to help with the races or go and observe.
10. Information will be posted on Facebook in case any new members want to order Trail Users shirts.
11. Kathleen Henley suggested that a trash can be placed in the woods on the Frog Hollow Trail. She will investigate types of cans that could work and a plan will be developed. Parks may be contacted, though members of the group may be able to collect the trash from the receptacle.
