Notes from the April 13, 2022 Meeting Last Flight Brewing Co.

- 1. Kathleen Henley reported the Treasury has a balance of \$648.42 thanks to some generous donations and membership dues renewals. Celeste will remind people to renew their \$15 annual membership.
- 2. There are currently 535 members in the Facebook group.
- 3. Trail work will take place again at Frog Hollow from 9:00 am to noon on the Serve JC Day, April 23. Kevin said that paver blocks have been delivered and moved to the end of the bridge by the woods. These will be set in place during the work session so the area is not so muddy. Others who participate can go lopping. Participants can eat pancakes at McClung Park starting at 8:00 am or just arrive at the main parking lot on West Edgewood at 9:00 am. Bring loppers or shovels. Some tools will be provided.
- 4. New signs are planned for Frog Hollow. The group decided to donate \$500 to the Jefferson City Parks Foundation to cover the cost of the signs. The signs will be similar to the new signs at Binder. The Frog Hollow trail currently has six segments called Segment 1, Segment 2, etc. Better names are needed.
