Notes from the September 14, 2022 Meeting

1. Kathleen Henley reported the treasury has a balance of \$386.93 after the fundraiser. The fundraiser was successful with sales of almost \$250 (some people have ordered pictures and they will be paying when those are delivered). Several good ideas were mentioned for next year's fundraiser including updating the JC Trail User's postcard. There was no change in membership.

2. There are currently 660 members in the Facebook group.

3. There will be a Get Acquainted Hike on September 17 at 1:00 pm at Scrivner Conservation Area. Theresa Buhr has planned a route for the Scrivner hike. [It was held and the area is very scenic.] The date for the October hike may not work for many to attend so it will be discussed again at the October meeting.

4. The Parks budget situation has been in the news. Celeste had talked to Todd Spalding, the JC Parks Director, and there may be a ceremony that emphasizes the group's partnership with Parks in the future, perhaps when the new signs at Frog Hollow are installed. Kevin Schwartz will start working on those sometime in mid to late October. Celeste will check to see if he has adequate funding.

5. Good news: the city has been awarded a grant to improve the crosswalk on Edgewood and a new section of greenway will be built on city property along Tree Valley.

6. Binder trail work will be held in conjunction with the NICA race team on September 17 at 8:00 am. [It was held and a lot was accomplished.]
