Notes from the November 16, 2022 Meeting

1. Kathleen Henley sent a report that the treasury has a balance of \$401.93 and there was no change in paid memberships in the last month.
2. There are currently 724 members in the Facebook group.
3. There will be a Community Hike to celebrate "National Take a Hike Day" on November 19. Meet at 1:30 pm at the old Bait Shop at Binder Lake to hike in the woods for about an hour. This hike is being held in conjunction with JC Parks. So far more than 300 people have said they are interested or going. The idea of having another Community Hike on January 1, a "First Day" hike on Twisted Sister, will be presented to Parks.
4. Members with substantial interest in the Trail Users group will be invited to hike at Tree Valley and the Edgewood greenway on December 4 at 1:30 pm. A new segment of the greenway will be built on city property along Tree Valley. JC Trails Users have been big supporters of this in the past and individuals sent more than 30 letters and emails requesting the extension.
5. There will be more raking trail work at Frog Hollow. The next date is Sunday, November 20, from 1:00-2:00 pm.
6. The Lions Club put in a water fountain along the Hyde Park portion of the greenway. Celeste will draft a letter thanking them for this trail amenity and expressing the group's encouragement for similar projects in the future. David Crenshaw will sign it.
7. Celeste asked if the idea of "Give a present to a trail near you" would be of interest to others near Christmas and the group identified several problems with this concept so it was discarded.
8. There is no meeting in December. The next meeting date is January 11, 2023 from 5:00-6:00 pm at Last Flight Brewing Company, 738 Heisinger Road.
