Those attending were Brandy Bergthold, Celeste Koon, Mike and Jane Lester, Rick Thom, Brian Collett, Veronica Mecko, and Karen Dunkle.

- 1. Kathleen Henley sent a treasury report showing \$276.30 is still in the account after the group donated \$1,200 to Jefferson City Parks in December for kiosks and signs at Binder Lake. There are 25 members who have paid dues.
- 2. There are 3,184 followers and 1,022 visitors for the group's Facebook page. (We don't know how Facebook determines these categories.)
- 3. The next Community Hike will be held at 1:30 pm on March 9 at the McClung Park hiking trail. Meet near the outdoor picnic pavilion. Celeste and Ben Hinz worked on a proposed schedule of Community Hikes through August. Jane Lester proposed a wonderful route on April 6 for the hike near the Lincoln greenway. Celeste will work on the revising the hike's description with Jane and Ben, and send a revised schedule to all. The dates of Future Community Hikes have been listed in the JC Parks program guide. The dates of Community Hikes for the next few months will be March 9, April 6, May 4, June 7, July 12, and August 9.

- 5. Celeste had emailed materials that Ashley Wiskirchen from Parks has prepared for the Trails Challenge 2025. Celeste will meet with Ashley next week to discuss these a little more and find out about the prizes that the Trail Users might provide. If anyone has comments, they can send those to Celeste.
